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DISCUSSION

Community service has been carried out at MA Islamiyah, Tangerang district. The number of participants who took part in this activity were 45 students of class XI. This socialization activity was carried out with several preparations including: Administration, tools, consumption and socialization materials.

The administrative preparation that was carried out was an application for permission from the head of the STIKes Faathir Husada Tangerang, the class XI supervising teacher, class XI students and the head of the YPI MA Islamiyah institution who had recommended socialization to all class XI students. Dissemination and delivery of material on Effective Communication through power points and also LCD projectors and the method of delivering them with lectures. The presentation of the material lasted for 40 minutes, before the delivery of the material began with pre-test activities for students to find out the extent of their knowledge of the material to be discussed, after which it was continued with the delivery of material starting with matters included in communicating effectively.
