This questionnaire is a posttest of extension activities. The post test is given to evaluate the achievement goals of the extension. Posttest scores are obtained in the same way as the pretest. The pretest and posttest scores were then compared to see whether there was an increase in participants' knowledge. If there is an increase of 16 in more than 80% of participants or in 54 participants, then the extension activity is considered successful.
